

Restricted Registration Guidelines
General Internal Medicine

1. Restricted Registration will be available for residents within the program (at PGY4 or PGY5 level) who meet the standards as outlined below and with approval of Program Director.
2. Moonlighting under Restricted Registration is restricted to Critical Care in the four Hamilton hospitals. Residents will have completed a minimum of 2 months of ICU rotations and 1 month of CCU rotation. Residents will be supervised by staff physicians/clinical fellows.
3. Residents cannot moonlight in ICU if they are at that site for the mandatory rotation in ICU.
4. Restricted Registration must strictly adhere to the PAIRO contract and any violations will result in immediate withdrawal of privileges. In summary, residents cannot be post-call for any day-time duty and cannot do more than two weekends on call per month, including any call required by the program.
5. In order to be eligible for restricted registration, residents must continue to achieve adequate evaluations and cannot receive any provisional satisfactory or unsatisfactory evaluations. In the event of a provisional satisfactory or unsatisfactory evaluation, the resident will be withdrawn from the Restricted Registration Program.
